Holistic and Adaptive Experiential Learning Designs and Assessments

Dr. Mai P. Trinh will discuss principles of holistic class designs and assessments based on Kolb's Experiential Learning Theory. She will share examples from her own teaching and research that can be adapted to different delivery modalities and different class sizes.

Mai P. Trinh is an Assistant Professor in the Faculty of Leadership and Integrative Studies at Arizona State University. She studies leader development from the perspectives of experiential learning and complex adaptive system. She believes that leader development is a holistic and experiential process that requires coordinating efforts among interdependent, heterogeneous agents such as leaders, group members, and their operating environments. She uses principles of Kolb's Experiential Learning Theory coupled with peer and executive coaching to help current and aspiring leaders foster a positive learning identity, embody practical wisdom, embrace humility, appreciate diversity, value teamwork, and adapt effectively to uncertain and changing contexts. Her research and teaching help people realize and enact their leadership portfolio and equip them with the skills to be able to navigate complexity, anticipate ambiguity, sustain and thrive in their local organizations and communities. Trinh earned her Ph.D. in Organizational Behavior from the Weatherhead School of Management at Case Western Reserve University.
