Scope

This policy applies to all undergraduate students enrolled at Bethune-Cookman University.

Definitions

Double Major: The earning of two degrees concurrently and graduating in the same semester with both.

Policy

A student may graduate with two baccalaureate degrees in the same semester by:

1. Officially declaring both majors by the attainment of 60 earned credit hours
2. Completing all requirements for both majors but the requirements must be completed concurrently.

Students who earn two Bachelor of Science degrees will receive one diploma with both degree names listed on it, and students who earn a Bachelor of Arts and a Bachelor of Science will receive two diplomas. Students must use the same catalog year for both degrees.

If a student completes the requirements for one degree in a semester prior to the completion of the other declared degree, the completed degree will be awarded and the student will need to readmit to complete the second major.
